Post I

In addition, the methods which have the opposite effect and positively impact the relations between clients and dealers are considered as well.

It is quite interesting, however, to know what reasons stand behind choosing the settings such as at the sales of vehicles, body shop repairs, and normal maintenance repairs. In addition, the duration of the observation is remained unsettled. Moreover, the author does not indicate the way the data will be analyzed. I should also note there are certain doubts as to use of hidden camera without the permission of the people who will be recorded as it could be considered as unethical practice.

Speaking about the similarities and differences of two posts, I would like to notify that both of them are written in details and are rather exhaustive. They provide an exact account of the steps that will be taken during the experiment, as well as the signify about the importance and practical relevance of the results.

Reading the post, I was quite confused with the term negative communication. In some parts of the post this term refers to actually different life situations and ways of communication, so that one can easily get confused about the object of the research which is t determined rather clearly. Therefore, I would like to recommend the author to explain what is meant by the term 'negative or bad communication.' In addition, I would advise the researcher to rely more on the

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interviews as they will actually provide the information of true feelings and thoughts of the parties of communication, not the opinions of the researcher which could be biased or impartial.
